

New Refuse Collection Contractor

On June 4, 2018 the St. Charles City Council voted to approve a five-year residential refuse/recycling contract with Lakeshore Recycling Systems. The current contract with Advanced Disposal runs through June 30, 2018. Lakeshore will begin collections July 1, 2018. **However, stickers and half-size bags from Advanced Disposal will be accepted through July 31, 2018.** The program will remain the same, with some new options and at a lower cost. Please take a second look before leaving the pool and locker room when you visit to be sure you have everything. Here are a few pool reminders:



1. Hours are Sun-Thur 10a.m. to 10p.m. and Fri-Sat 10a.m. to 11p.m.
2. Keep all glass at the table area. Broken glass in the pool area is dangerous to feet and the pool pump.
3. Separate trash from recycling and put each in the correct container.
4. Take all food leftovers, and containers, with you in lieu of putting in the trash. This type of trash attracts the raccoons and they leave a horrible mess.
5. There are no more than 5 children allowed per adult in the pool area, again for safety reasons.

P.S. If these are your trunks or towel, come pick them up.

Units 34 - 36

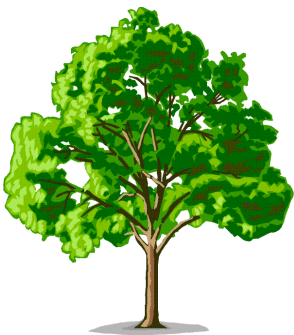
Units 14 - 16

Tree Trimming & Removal



We are in the process of having extensive tree work done in various places within The Oaks. A few trees will be coming down because they have died, or are failing badly, and they need to be removed before they begin to lose limbs that could cause injury or damage. Additionally, many trees will also be trimmed away from buildings and dead branches removed. We are using two different tree services, so there will be two waves of work done.

If tree work is planned near your unit, you will receive a notice so you can have vehicles, etc. removed from the area where work is being done.
